The Online Platform Guide provides details about how to ensure your browser is compatible with the online platform, as well as a step by step guide to successfully logging in and navigating the site. The Online Platform Guide will be released to the ASX and is also available on our website at (https://www.pwah.com.au/site/investor-centre).

It is recommended that shareholders log in to the online platform at least 15 minutes prior to the scheduled start time for Meeting on a supported web browser on their computer or online device. To log in to the Meeting, shareholders will need their Shareholder Reference Number (**SRN**) or Holder Identification Number (**HIN**), which is printed at the top of their Proxy Form, along with their postcode.

Proxyholders will need a proxy code to log in. This will be provided by the share registry via email within 24 hours prior to the Meeting.

CONSIDERATION OF REPORTS

The first item of business is to receive and consider the Financial Report, the Directors' Report, and the Independent Auditor's Report of the Company for the financial year ended 30 June 2021.

All shareholders can view the Company's Annual Report which contains the Financial Report, the Directors' Report and the Independent Auditor's Report of the Company for the year ended 30 June 2021 on the Company's website at (https://www.pwah.com.au/site/investor-centre).

Shareholders are not required to vote on this item.

QUESTIONS AND COMMENTS

Following consideration of the Reports, the Chair of the Meeting will allow shareholders a reasonable opportunity to ask questions about or make comments on the business of the Meeting, the management of the Company or about the Company generally.

The Company's Auditor, Deloitte, will attend the Meeting and there will be a reasonable opportunity for shareholders to ask the Auditor questions relevant to:

- a. the conduct of the audit;
- b. the preparation and content of the Independent Auditor's Report;
- c. the accounting policies adopted by the Company in relation to the preparation of the financial statements; and

d. the independence of the Auditor in relation to the conduct of the audit.

The Chair will also give the Auditor a reasonable opportunity to answer any written questions submitted by shareholders prior to the Meeting that are relevant to the content of the Independent Auditor's Report or the conduct of the audit.

ITEMS FOR APPROVAL

Resolution 1. Re-election of Director – John Ingram

To consider and, if thought fit, pass the following as an ordinary resolution of the Company:

"That John Ingram, who retires in accordance with clause 6.2(c) of the Company's Constitution and being eligible for election, is re-elected as a Director of the Company."

Resolution 2. Remuneration Report

To consider and if thought fit, pass the following as a non-binding ordinary resolution of the Company:

"That, the Company's Remuneration Report for the financial year ended 30 June 2021, be adopted."

The Remuneration Report is contained in the 2021 Annual Report (available at (https://www.pwah.com.au/site/investor-centre). Please note that, in accordance with section 250R(3) of the *Corporations Act* 2001 (Cth) (**Corporations Act**), the vote on this resolution is advisory only and does not bind the Directors or the Company.

Voting Exclusion Statement

A vote on Resolution 2 must not be cast (in any capacity) by, or on behalf of, the following persons:

- a. a member of the key management personnel (**KMP**) whose remuneration details are included in the 2021 Remuneration Report; or
- b. a closely related party of such a KMP (including close family members and companies the KMP controls).

However, a person described above may cast a vote on Resolution 2 as a proxy if the vote is not cast on behalf of a person described above and either:

- a. the proxy appointment is in writing that specifies the way the proxy is to vote on the resolution; or
- b. the vote is cast by the chair of the Meeting and the appointment of the chair as proxy:
 - i. does not specify the way the proxy is to vote on the resolution; and
 - ii. expressly authorises the chair to exercise the proxy even if the resolution is connected directly or indirectly with the remuneration of a member of the KMP.

"Key management personnel" and "closely related party" have the same meaning as set out in the Corporations Act.

In addition and in accordance with section 250BD of the Corporations Act, a vote must not be cast on Resolution 2 as a proxy by a member of the KMP at the date of the AGM, or a closely related party of those persons, unless it is cast as proxy for a person entitled to vote in accordance with their directions. This restriction on voting undirected proxies does not apply to the Chair of the Meeting where the proxy appointment expressly authorises the Chair of the Meeting to exercise undirected proxies even if the resolution is connected, directly or indirectly, with the remuneration of the KMP.

Resolution 3. Appointment of Deloitte Touche Tohmatsu (Deloitte) as Auditor

To consider and, if thought fit, to pass the following as an ordinary resolution of the Company:

"That, in accordance with section 327B(1)(a) of the Corporations Act 2001 (Cth) and for all other purposes Deloitte Touche Tohmatsu having been nominated by a shareholder and consented in writing to act in the capacity of Auditor, be appointed as the Auditor of Peter Warren Automotive Holdings Limited."

ENTITLEMENT TO ATTEND AND VOTE

In accordance with regulation 7.11.37 of the Corporations Regulations 2001 (Cth), the Board has determined that persons who are registered holders of shares of the Company as at 7:00 pm (AEDT) on Sunday, 24 October 2021 will be entitled to attend and vote at the AGM as a shareholder (ie, through the online platform).

If more than one joint holder of shares is present at the AGM (whether personally, by proxy or by attorney or by representative) and tenders a vote, only the vote of the joint holder whose name appears first on the register will be counted.

Appointment of Proxy

If you are a shareholder entitled to attend and vote, you may appoint an individual or a body corporate as a proxy to attend and act on your behalf at the 2021 AGM. If a body corporate is appointed as a proxy, that body corporate must ensure that it appoints a corporate representative in accordance with section 250D of the Corporations Act to exercise its powers as proxy at the AGM.

A proxy need not be a shareholder of the Company.

A shareholder may appoint up to two proxies and specify the proportion or number of votes each proxy may exercise. If the shareholder does not specify the proportion or number of votes to be exercised, each proxy may exercise half of the shareholder's votes.

To be valid, a proxy form must be received by the Company in the manner stipulated above. The Company reserves the right to declare invalid any proxy not received in this manner.

Undirected proxies

If the Chair of the Meeting is appointed or taken to be appointed as a proxy and you do not specify in the Proxy Form the manner in which you wish the Chair to vote on the resolution to be considered at the Meeting, then by submitting your Proxy Form you will be expressly authorising the Chair to exercise your proxy on the relevant resolution. The Chair intends to exercise all available votes in favour of the resolution.

Power of Attorney

A proxy form and the original power of attorney (if any) under which the proxy form is signed (or a certified copy of that power of attorney or other authority) must be received by the Company no later than 1:00pm (AEDT) on Sunday, 24 October 2021.

Corporate Representatives

A body corporate which is a shareholder, or which has been appointed as a proxy, is entitled to appoint any person to act as its representative at the AGM.

The appointment of the representative must comply with the requirements under section 250D of the Corporations Act.

The representative should provide to the Company (via the Company's share registry, Link Market Services):

- a properly executed letter or other document; or
- a copy of the resolution, certified by the secretary or a director of the body corporate,

confirming the representative's appointment or authority to act as the company's representative. For this purpose, a "Certificate of Appointment of Corporate Representative" form may be obtained from the Company's share registry or online at www.linkmarketservices.com.au.

Body corporate representatives should lodge this documentation with the Company's share registry no later than 48 hours prior to the AGM, unless it has been previously given to the Company.

Voting at the Meeting

It is intended that voting on each of the proposed resolutions at this Meeting will be conducted by a poll, rather than on a show of hands. Shareholders vote using the online platform. Full instructions on how to do so are included in the Link Group Online Platform Guide

IMPORTANT: If you appoint the Chair of the Meeting as your proxy, or the Chair becomes your proxy by default, and you do not direct your proxy how to vote on Resolution 2 then by submitting the proxy form you will be expressly authorising the Chair to exercise your proxy on the resolution, even though the resolution is connected, directly or indirectly, with the remuneration of the KMP.

SHAREHOLDER QUESTIONS - SUBMITTED PRIOR TO THE MEETING

Shareholders who are unable to attend the Meeting or who may prefer to register questions in advance are invited to do so.

Please log onto www.linkmarketservices.com.au and select Voting then click 'Ask a Question'. To allow time to collate questions and prepare answers, please submit any questions by 19 October 2021.

Questions will be collated and during the AGM the Chair will seek to address as many of the more frequently raised topics as possible. However, there may not be sufficient time available at the AGM to address all topics raised. Please note that individual responses will not be sent to shareholders.

CONDUCT OF MEETING

Peter Warren is committed to ensuring that its shareholder meetings are conducted in a manner which provides those shareholders (or their proxy holders) who attend the Meeting with the opportunity to participate in the business of the Meeting in an orderly fashion and to ask questions about and comment on matters relevant to the business of the Meeting or about the Company generally.

Peter Warren will not allow conduct at any shareholder meeting which is discourteous to those who are present at the meeting, or which in any way disrupts or interferes with the proper conduct of the meeting.

The Chair of the Meeting will exercise his powers as the Chair to ensure that the meeting is conducted in an orderly and timely fashion, in the interests of all attending shareholders.

In the event that technical issues arise, Peter Warren will have regard to the impact of the technical issues on shareholders participating and casting votes online and the Chair of the Meeting may, in exercising his powers as the Chair, issue any instructions for resolving the issue and may continue the Meeting if it is appropriate to do so.

PARTICIPATION IN THE AGM

There are a number of ways shareholders and interested parties can participate in the AGM:

- **Online**: shareholders and proxyholders are encouraged to participate in the AGM online, which will allow them to view presentations, ask questions in writing and vote.
- <u>Teleconference</u>: for shareholders and proxyholders who are unable or do not wish to access the meeting online, this will allow them to listen to the Meeting live and ask questions on the telephone, but not vote. Shareholders wishing to participate by telephone will need to contact Link Market Services on +61 1800 990 363 to pre-register and obtain your unique PIN. Shareholders should pre-register by no later than 1:00pm (AEDT) on Sunday, 24 October 2021.

Please note that there may be a short delay when attending the AGM online.

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

This Explanatory Memorandum has been prepared for the information of shareholders of the Company (**Shareholders**) in relation to the business to be conducted at the Company's AGM to be held on Tuesday, 26 October 2021.

The purpose of this Explanatory Memorandum is to provide Shareholders with information that is reasonably required by Shareholders to decide how to vote upon the resolutions.

Subject to the abstentions noted below, the Directors unanimously recommend Shareholders vote in favour of all Resolutions. The Chair of the Meeting intends to vote all available undirected proxies in favour of each resolution.

Resolution 1, 3 and 4 are ordinary resolutions which require a simple majority of votes cast by Shareholders present and entitled to vote on the resolutions.

Resolution 2, relating to the Remuneration Report, is advisory only and does not bind the Directors or the Company.

Resolution 1. Re-Election of Director - John Ingram

John Ingram was appointed as a Director of the Company on 6 April 2021.

In accordance with clause 6.2(c) of the Constitution, Mr Ingram retires from office at the conclusion of the AGM and is eligible for re-election as a Director of the Company.

If shareholders do not approve the election of John Ingram, then he will cease to be a Director at the conclusion of the Meeting.

Mr Ingram is currently an Independent Non-Executive Director and Chairman of the Company and is a member of its Audit and Risk Committee and People and Remuneration Committee.

John is an experienced director and chairman, currently also serving as the non-executive chairman of Nick Scali Limited and having previously been the managing director of Crane Group Limited. John is also an Emeritus Councillor and a past National President of The Australian Industry Group.

The Board strongly supports the re-election of John Ingram as he will contribute to the Board with extensive experience in management, strategy, accounting and finance and retail.

For the reasons set out above, the Directors, with Mr Ingram abstaining, unanimously recommend Shareholders vote in favour of Resolution 1.

Resolution 2. Remuneration Report

Section 250R(2) of the Corporations Act requires that the section of the Directors' Report dealing with the remuneration of directors and key management personnel of the Company (**Remuneration Report**) be put to the vote of shareholders for adoption by way of a non-binding vote.

The vote on this resolution is advisory only and does not bind the Directors or the Company. However, the Board will take the outcome of the vote into account in setting remuneration policy for future years.

Shareholders can view the full Remuneration Report in the Annual Report which is available on Peter Warren's website at (https://www.pwah.com.au/site/investor-centre).

Following consideration of the Remuneration Report, the Chair of the Meeting will give shareholders a reasonable opportunity to ask questions about, or make comments on, the Remuneration Report.

The Directors abstain, in the interests of good corporate governance, from making a recommendation in relation to Resolution 2.

Resolution 3. Appointment of Deloitte Touche Tohmatsu as Auditor

Deloitte Touche Tohmatsu (**Deloitte**) has held the office of auditor since November 2016. Under section 327A(2) of the *Corporations Act 2001* (Cth) (the **Act**), Deloitte holds office until the Company's first AGM. Thereafter, section 327B(1)(a) of the Act requires Peter Warren to appoint an auditor at its first AGM. Deloitte has given, and has not withdrawn, its consent to act as external auditor of Peter Warren Automotive Holdings Limited.

In accordance with section 328B(1) of the Act, notice in writing nominating Deloitte as auditor has been given to the Company by a shareholder. A copy of this notice is contained in Attachment A to this Notice.

The Directors unanimously recommend Shareholders vote in favour of Resolution 3.

Please read and accept the terms and conditions before clicking on the blue 'Register and Watch Meeting' button.



Note: If you close your browser, your session will expire and you will need to re-register. If using the same email address, you can request a link to be emailed to you to log back in.

1. Get a Voting Card

To register to vote – click on the 'Get a Voting Card' button.

This will bring up a box which looks like this.

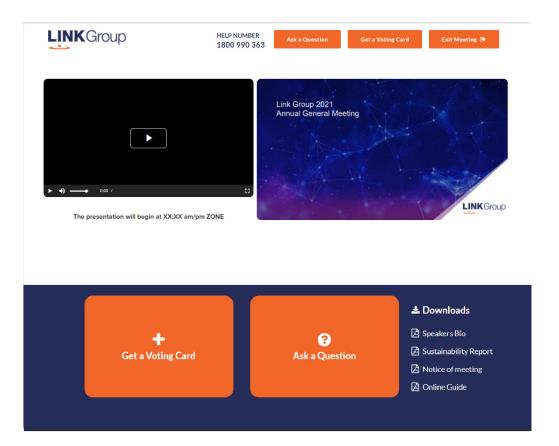


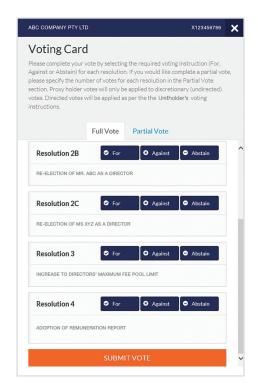
If you are an individual or joint securityholder you will need to register and provide validation by entering your securityholder number and postcode.

If you are an appointed Proxy, please enter the Proxy Number issued by Link in the PROXY DETAILS section. Then click the **'SUBMIT DETAILS AND VOTE'** button.

Once you have registered, your voting card will appear with all of the resolutions to be voted on by securityholders at the Meeting (as set out in the Notice of Meeting). You may need to use the scroll bar on the right hand side of the voting card to view all resolutions.

Securityholders and proxies can either submit a Full Vote or Partial Vote.





Full Votes

To submit a full vote on a resolution ensure you are in the 'Full Vote' tab. Place your vote by clicking on the 'For', 'Against', or 'Abstain' voting buttons.

Partial Votes

To submit a partial vote on a resolution ensure you are in the 'Partial Vote' tab. You can enter the number of votes (for any or all) resolution/s. The total amount of votes that you are entitled to vote for will be listed under each resolution. When you enter the number of votes it will automatically tally how many votes you have left.

Note: If you are submitting a partial vote and do not use all of your entitled votes, the un-voted portion will be submitted as No Instruction and therefore will not be counted.

Once you have finished voting on the resolutions scroll down to the bottom of the box and click on the 'Submit Vote' or 'Submit Partial Vote' button.

Note: You can close your voting card without submitting your vote at any time while voting remains open. Any votes you have already made will be saved for the next time you open up the voting card. The voting card will appear on the bottom left corner of the webpage. The message **'Not yet submitted'** will appear at the bottom of the page.

You can edit your voting card at any point while voting is open by clicking on 'Edit Card'. This will reopen the voting card with any previous votes made.

At the conclusion of the Meeting a red bar with a countdown timer will appear at the top of the Webcast and Slide windows advising the remaining voting time. Please make any changes and submit your voting cards.

Once voting has been closed all submitted voting cards cannot be changed.

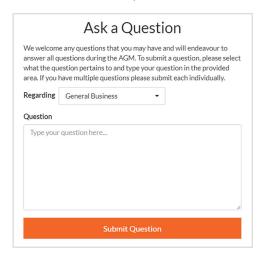

2. How to ask a question

Note: Only securityholders are eligible to ask questions.

If you have yet to obtain a voting card, you will prompted to enter your securityholder number or proxy details before you can ask a question. To ask a question, click on the 'Ask a Question' button either at the top or bottom of the webpage.

The 'Ask a Question' box will then pop up with two sections for completion.



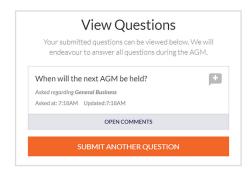
In the 'Regarding' section click on the drop down arrow and select the category/resolution for your question.

Click in the 'Question' section and type your question and click on 'Submit'.

A 'View Questions' box will appear where you can view your questions at any point. Only you can see the questions you have asked.

If your question has been answered and you would like to exercise your right of reply, you can submit another question.

Note that not all questions are guaranteed to be answered during the Meeting, but we will do our best to address your concerns.



3. Downloads

4. Voting closing

Voting will end 5 minutes after the close of the Meeting.

At the conclusion of the Meeting a red bar with a countdown timer will appear at the top of the Webcast and Slide screens advising the remaining voting time. If you have not submitted your vote, you should do so now.

Note: If your holding cannot be verified by the moderator, you will attend the Meeting as a visitor and will not be able to ask a question.

Asking a Question

Step 1

When the Chairman calls for questions on each resolution, you will be asked to **press *1** on your keypad should you wish to raise your hand to ask a question.

Step 2

Please advise if your question relates to an item of business or General Business. The moderator will make a note and ask if you have any additional questions.

Step 3

When it is time to ask your question, the moderator will introduce you to the meeting, your line will be unmuted and you can then start speaking.

Note: If at any time you no longer wish to ask your question, you can lower your hand by **pressing *2** on your key pad. If you have also joined the Meeting Online, we ask that you mute your laptop, desktop, tablet or mobile device while you ask your question.

Step 4

Your line will be muted once your question has been answered.
